**ORDER**

On October 22, 2004, the respondent David Michael Shapiro, his counsel Michael L. Rigsby and Bar Counsel Barbara Ann Williams appeared before the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board to present an Agreed Disposition.

Based upon the agreement of the parties and the arguments of counsel, the Disciplinary Board finds there is clear and convincing evidence that the Respondent currently suffers from a Disability, and it is hereby

**ORDERED** that upon entry of this Order, the respondent Michael David Shapiro is suspended from the practice of law in the Commonwealth of Virginia pursuant to Part Six, Section IV, paragraph 13.I.6.e.(1) of the Rules of Court;

It is further **ORDERED** that the parties shall agree to dismiss without prejudice or continue generally the misconduct matters currently pending before a three-judge panel in the Circuit Court of the City of Richmond, Case No. LS-1784-1;


